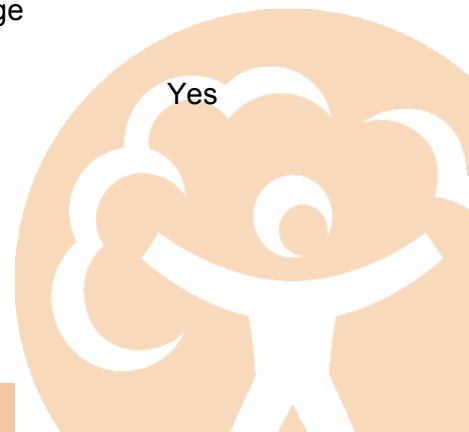

Listed below are the locks that will be closed during the 2016 to 2017 investment programme. The locks will be closed from the first date listed and re-open the day after the final date.

Canoe portage with care during closure

Buscot Lock	16 January 2017 to 27 January 2017 Repairing and making health and safety improvements to lock gate sluices and seals.	Yes
Shifford Lock	9 January 2017 to 24 February 2017 Re-sheeting lock gates, repairing balance beam and re-fixing rubbing timber.	Yes
*King's Lock (1)	1 November 2016 to 16 December 2016 Re-sheeting lock gates, repairing balance beam and removing silt from travel lines of the lock gates.	Yes
*King's Lock (2)	9 January 2017 to 3 March 2017 Head mooring embankment works and additional revenue moorings.	Yes
Clifton Lock	13 February 2017 to 17 March 2017 Repairing lock gates.	Yes
Day's Lock	14 November 2016 to 25 November 2016 Replacing sluice rod.	Yes
Goring Lock	1 November 2016 to 16 December 2016 Refurbishing lock chamber walls and replacing of worn rubbing timbers.	Yes
Marlow Lock	9 January 2017 to 10 February 2017 Replacing lock chamber rubbing timbers and re-fixing all grab chains.	Yes
Old Windsor (upstream Lock Cut)	1 November 2016 to 23 January 2017 Refurbishment and strengthening of the lock cut bridge by Thames Water.	Yes
Penton Hook Lock	1 November 2016 to 16 December 2016 Repairing lock gates.	Yes
